Manufacturing Process

Dibond plates are made from a high grade Aluminium Sheet material, after shaping the plates on our CNC router a laminated vinyl graphic is applied to the panel.

This product has proved to be an excellent outdoor solution; however, as with all outdoor signage there is a degree of maintenance needed to keep the signs and plaques looking their best.

Procedure

Ideally monthly, but at 2-3 times per year, all Dibond should be washed with mild detergent and water to remove any surface marks, at the same time being assessed for any damage or degradation that may require treatment.

Graffiti

An "Anti-Graffiti" protection can be applied to Dibond panels at the manufacturing stage. However, this can be quite expensive and therefore quite often not cost effective to do so.

Vandalism

Physical damage, scratches, gouges and paint graffiti are usually irreparable. A replacement panel is often the only solution, contact Pinseeker for more information.
